Dear Taxpayer:

This letter is to inform you of a change in the allocation of our sales and use unabated school tax rate adopted by the City Council of the City of Pell City. The vast majority of taxpayers will not see any change to their taxes because this was not a change to the total percentage remitted, only the allocation between the city and the school system. Effective October 1st, 2014 at 12:01 a.m., the sales and use unabated school tax rate decreased by .20%, and the tax rate for the city increased by .20%. The City will continue to share the proper percentage of tax as approved by the City Council with the City of Pell City School System in an effort to keep the education of our children top priority.

As usual, taxes are due and payable by the 20th day of the month following the month of collection. Penalties and interest will accrue beginning on the 21st day.

A revised tax form is enclosed reflecting the changes for your convenience. A taxpayer must qualify under the Tax Incentive Reform Act of 1992 and must be under an Abatement Certificate/Agreement to receive abatement privileges. The tax rates and new unabated rates are as follows:

This decrease will not have any effect on the rates currently charged by the State of Alabama Department of Revenue or the St. Clair County Sales Tax Department.
