

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-4045

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES 2000-1476
AND 1989-852 AND ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR
THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PELL CITY, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELL CITY,
ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance 2000-1476 which purportedly established the position of Mayor as a full-time position and which did, in fact, set the Mayor's salary at \$55,000.00 and conferred upon the position of Mayor the benefits of a full-time employee of the City is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: Ordinance 1989-852 which appointed the Mayor as the fulltime Superintendent of the Pell City Water and Sewer Systems and set the Mayor's compensation for such service is hereby repealed in its entirety.


Section 3: The salary of the Mayor of the City of Pell City shall be and is hereby fixed at \$15,000 annually payable in equal monthly installments.

Section 4: Any and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.



Section 6: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the first Monday in November, 2012.


