The City Council of the City of Pell City met in a special called session at the City Hall on Monday, August 31, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. for the purpose of canvassing the votes from the August 25, 2020 Municipal Election. Present were Council President James McGowan, Councilmembers Jay Jenkins, Blaine Henderson and Jason Mitcham. Councilman Jud Alverson was absent. Those present constituting a quorum of the council, the following business was transacted:

The invocation was led by City Attorney John Rea.

The pledge to the American flag was led by Councilman Jason Mitcham.

The City Clerk had roll call for attendance.

On motion of Councilman Jenkins, seconded by Councilman Henderson, the council unanimously approved the agenda as presented.

A total of nineteen (19) provisional ballots were cast. The Board of Registrars certified that eight (8) ballots out of the nineteen (19) cast were acceptable. City Clerk Penny Isbell read aloud the acceptable votes cast by the provisional ballots. Assistant City Clerk Sheree Pruitt verified those called out by Ms. Isbell were acceptable.

On motion of Councilman Jenkins, seconded by Councilman Henderson, the council unanimously approved the following resolution certifying the election results:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pell City, Alabama, as follows:

1. That William "Bill" Pruitt, IV received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Mayor, and he is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.

2. That Ivi McDaniel received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember District No. 2, and she is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.

3. That Jason Mitcham received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember District No. 4, and he is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.

4. That Laurie Mize Henderson received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Member District No. 3, and she is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.

5. That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Member District No. 4, and that Tammie Williams and Gregory "Greg" Crump received the most and second most votes cast for that office, therefore, a runoff election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 *et seq.*, of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended.

6. That Norman D. Wilder received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Member District No. 5, and he is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.

On motion of Councilman Henderson, seconded by Councilman Jenkins, the council adjourned subject to the call of the Council President.
