- 4. That Laurie Mize Henderson received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Member District No. 3, and she is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.
- 5. That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Member District No. 4, and that Tammie Williams and Gregory "Greg" Crump received the most and second most votes cast for that office, therefore, a runoff election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 *et seq.*, of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended.
- 6. That Norman D. Wilder received a majority of the votes cast for the office of School Board Member District No. 5, and he is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.
