## STATE OF ALABAMA ST. CLAIR COUNTY

The City Council of the City of Pell City met in an Emergency Called Council Meeting at City Hall at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 29, 2022. Present were Council President Pro-Tem Jason Mitcham, Councilmembers Jay Jenkins, Ivi McDaniel, and Jason Mitcham. Council President Alverson and Councilmember Blaine Henderson were absent. Those present constituting a quorum of the Council, Council President Pro-Tem Mitcham opened the meeting for discussion.

The City Clerk had roll call for attendance.

On motion of Councilmember McDaniel, seconded by Councilmember Jenkins, the Council unanimously approved the Agenda as presented.

City Manager Brian Muenger explained that a water pipe had burst at city property located at 111 20<sup>th</sup> Street North, which was currently occupied by Community Corrections and Pardons & Paroles. Mr. Muenger advised it was necessary that the repairs be declared an emergency due to the lease agreement with the occupants which states that the City would responsible for providing space for the tenants, which would cost the City additional unnecessary funds. He confirmed that if approved the repairs could be made promptly and it would not be necessary for the City to provide another space for the tenants to be able to operate.

On motion of Councilmember Jenkins, seconded by Councilmember McDaniel, the Council unanimously **RESOLUTION NO. 2022** – **5822** declaring the repairs for certain property damage an emergency and authorize the expenditure of funds.

On motion of Councilmember Jenkins, seconded by Councilmember McDaniel, the Council adjourned, subject to the call of Council President Pro-Tem Mitcham.
